

PROGRAM OFFERING

Minimal Risk (Level I-10 hours of risk education)

Drivers Risk Education is a minimum ten-hour program of substance abuse education mandated by the State of Illinois for DUI offenders classified as being at minimal risk. Clients are required to attend classes for four (4) two and one-half hour sessions (2.5). Upon successful completion of the course, clients are given a certificate of completion to present to the courts and Secretary of State. **Cost - \$150.00**

Moderate Risk (Level IIM - 10 hours of risk education, 12 hours of early intervention)

Moderate Risk classes consist of ten (10) hours of risk education as detailed above along with twelve (12) hours of early intervention counseling. Upon completion of the four (4) two and one-half hour Risk Education sessions, clients will complete counseling sessions twice a week for two and one-half hours over a period of three weeks. Upon completion of the course, clients are given a certificate of completion for their Risk Education course, along with a completed Secretary of State treatment verification form. Treatment plan summary and Discharge summary along with any other necessary supporting documentation. **Cost - \$350.00**

Significant Risk (Level IIS- 10 hours of risk education, 20 hours of substance abuse counseling)

Significant Risk classes consist often (10) hours of risk education as detailed above along with twenty (20) hours of substance abuse counseling. Upon completion of the four (4) two and one-half hour Risk Education sessions, clients will complete counseling sessions twice a week for two and one-half hours over a period of four weeks. Upon completion of the course, clients are given a certificate of completion for their Risk Education course, along with a completed Secretary of State treatment verification form, Treatment plan summary and Discharge Summary along with any other necessary supporting documentation. Additionally, all clients will be given an aftercare plan and will be required to attend aftercare sessions for two (2) hours a month over a period of six months. **Cost - \$775.00**

High Risk (Level III-75 hours of Intensive Outpatient Treatment)

High Risk classes consist of seventy-five (75) hours of intensive outpatient alcohol and substance abuse treatment. Clients are required to attend the sessions three (3) times a week for three (3) hours each session. After seventy-five hours of counseling have been completed, the client will be given a completed Secretary of State treatment verification form, Treatment plan summary and Discharge Summary along with any other necessary supporting documentation. Additionally, all clients will be given an aftercare plan with additional recommendations for services (if necessary) and will be required to attend aftercare sessions twice (2) monthly for two (2) hours/session over the period of one year. **Cost - \$2000.00**
