

S. Ill. man faces 11th DUI charge in 2 states

BELLEVILLE, Ill. - A southern Illinois man faces his 11th DUI charge after police say he was drunk when he caused a crash this week.

Police say 48-year-old Matthew Roth of Millstadt had just left an alcohol treatment facility when he forced several motorists off the road Thursday and crashed. A judge had ordered him to live at the treatment center after a June arrest.

Records show the former Marine has been charged with DUI six times in Illinois since 2007 and has four DUI convictions in [Missouri](#). Not all his Illinois arrests resulted in convictions.

Roth is being held in the St. Clair County Jail on \$200,000 bail. He was charged Friday with felony driving under the influence and misdemeanor driving on a suspended license.

No injuries were reported in Thursday's crash.
